2. **Consideration, Discussion and Action:** To appoint Melanie McCrary to a 3year term on the Watonga Public Library Board starting June 2020 and end April 2023, as recommended by Mayor Gary Olsen and Librarian Terri Crawford.
  
3. **Consideration, Discussion and Action:** To renew the Contract with the Friends of the Ferguson Museum. The contract is for \$8000 per year to assist with salaries for part time employees. The Contract is to keep the Museum open 20 hours per week. This equates to approximately \$7.69 per hour. This contract will take effect July 1, 2020. (We are still awaiting clear title of the Museum Property to assume full operations.)

4. **Consideration, Discussion and Action:** To solicit sealed bids to lease the property known as the Huff-Lorang Agriculture Lease for a term of one year and with the same terms as the current lease agreement. The current lease will expire June 30, 2020. Bids to be accepted until 4:00 PM Tuesday June 23, 2020. Bids will be opened at that time and a recommendation will be made to Watonga City Council at the next regular Council Meeting on July 7, 2020. Said property is approximately 63.23 acres. Legal Description; The Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section 18, Township 16 North, Range 11 West of the Indian Meridian, in Blaine County, Oklahoma, LESS AND EXCEPT a tract of land described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said SE/4 Section, thence North 1075.3 feet, thence East 884 feet, thence South 1075.3 feet, thence West 884 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 21.82 acres more or less and LESS AND EXCEPT 44.75 acres in the Northwest corner thereof which is used for and known as Huff-Lorang Park, and LESS AND EXCEPT 3.2 acres bounded on the North and West by railroad right of way, on the South by 11<sup>th</sup> Street and on the East by Laing Street.
